



UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS & EXPECTATIONS

All students of Trinity College should show their belonging and loyalty to their school community by wearing the school and sporting uniform fully and with pride. The uniform is to be worn between home and school, in class and on other occasions as required. When wearing the College uniform, students must ensure their uniform is neat and correct, whether on or off campus.

Students are not permitted to attend class unless in full and correct school uniform.

Each student is to wear the prescribed school uniform including appropriate sports clothing for physical education classes and participation in intra- or inter-school activities. Parents must contact the Director of Students if their child is going to be out of uniform.

When attending school excursions, students must wear full and correct school uniform, unless otherwise directed by the staff member in charge of the excursion.

All items of uniform will be sold from the Trinity College Uniform Shop and will carry the school logo, including the compulsory Trinity College Back Pack. It is compulsory that all students wear these correctly monogrammed items.

All items of the uniform should be **clearly** and **permanently** marked with the student's name.

The items of uniform for summer, winter and sport for girls and boys are listed below. Mixing of uniform is not permitted.

FOOTWEAR

* Some shoes are marketed as school shoes. However, Trinity College requires students to wear the traditional black school shoe, that have a raised heel, NOT the variety resembling black runners.

Likewise, Trinity College expects sports shoes to be ones designated for sporting activity, not soft canvas shoes or street wear shoes, as they do not have adequate cushioning and support for safe participation.

Note that all footwear must be worn correctly.

All decisions on appropriate footwear are at the discretion of the Principal.

NOTE:

1. Additional warmth may be gained from appropriate plain white undergarments which must not be visible.
2. Students undertaking practical subjects are required to wear appropriate protective clothing, in particular:
 - a) For Art and Technology students must wear a covering for their uniform.
 - b) For Science, Technology and Foods solid shoes must be worn.

SUMMER UNIFORM

GIRLS

Trinity College Blazer (optional), Trinity College check dress (must be an appropriate length), Trinity College jumper, short white socks, polishable black school shoes*. No boots or sports shoes. Trinity College wide-brimmed hat must be worn when outside during Terms 1 & 4. No open-toed footwear is allowed. Trinity College waterproof jacket.

BOYS

Trinity College Blazer (optional), Trinity College grey shorts and grey socks OR grey permanent press trousers, white button through business style shirt, Trinity College jumper, polishable black lace-up school shoes*. No boots or sports shoes. Trinity College wide brimmed hat must be worn when outside during Terms 1 & 4. No open toed footwear is allowed. Trinity College waterproof jacket.

WINTER UNIFORM

GIRLS

Trinity College Blazer (optional), navy slacks OR Trinity College kilt with navy tights or navy socks, white button through business style shirt, Trinity College jumper, Trinity College waterproof jacket, polishable black school shoes*. No boots or sports shoes. The Trinity College tie is optional, but must be worn correctly. Trinity College navy blue scarves and navy blue full-fingered gloves may be worn. Kilts must be at least knee length.

BOYS

Trinity College Blazer (optional), grey permanent press trousers, white button through business style shirt, Trinity College jumper, Trinity College waterproof jacket, polishable black lace-up school shoes*. No boots or sports shoes. The Trinity College tie is optional, but must be worn correctly. Trinity College navy blue scarves and navy blue full-fingered gloves may be worn.

SPORTS UNIFORM - FOR ALL STUDENTS

Trinity College navy shorts, House colour polo shirt, Trinity College rugby top, white sport socks and sports shoes appropriate for sport*, plain navy Trinity College track trousers, Trinity College waterproof jacket. Trinity College wide brimmed hat must be worn when outside during Terms 1 and 4.

The sports uniform may be worn to school in place of normal school uniform on days of double physical education classes or sporting activity as well as for double classes of Outdoor Recreation in Years 11 and 12.

JEWELLERY, HAIR STYLES AND ACCESSORIES

These guidelines are set in the context of the school's attempt to ensure consistent neatness and cleanliness, as well as accepting responsibility for the health and safety of students in and out of class.

- Sleepers or studs may be worn with a maximum of two per ear – large or hoop earrings must not be worn.
- No visible tattoos or visible body piercings (such as facial studs or rings) are permitted.
- One fine gold or silver necklace or fine chain may be worn, with no hanging attachments.
- Only one bangle or ID bracelet may be worn.
- No more than one small ring may be worn in total.
- Clear nail polish only may be worn.
- Hairstyles must be appropriate to the purpose of school and must not be exaggerated in colour or style.

Highlights or tints must be in a natural hair colour (not blue, pink etc.) Mohawk, clean-shaved heads and dreadlocks are examples of exaggerated styles, which are not acceptable.

- Male students are expected to be clean shaven at all times.
- Hair accessories (such as ribbons) must be navy blue and must be purchased from the uniform shop.
- No make-up is allowed.
- No beanies or caps are allowed.
- Only navy blue, full fingered gloves and Trinity College navy blue scarves purchased from the Uniform Shop are permitted to be worn outside class time.

If in any doubt please contact the Director of Students for clarification. The Principal reserves the right to determine what is appropriate in all cases outlined above.
